FULL FUNDING

Coverage: Full tuition + living + flights for Commonwealth nations incl. Pakistan

Who: Masters & PhD | Awarded by: Commonwealth Scholarship Commission

Gates Cambridge Scholarship

FULL FUNDING

Coverage: Full Cambridge fees + £18,000/yr living + extras

Who: Masters & PhD at Cambridge only | Awarded by: Gates Foundation

GREAT Scholarship

PARTIAL

Coverage: £10,000 toward tuition fees for Pakistani students

Who: Undergrad & Masters | Awarded by: British Council Pakistan

HEC Overseas Scholarship

PARTIAL

Coverage: Monthly stipend + partial tuition support

Who: Masters & PhD | Awarded by: HEC Pakistan

A Levels	Typical offer: AAA to ABB depending on university and course
IGCSE / O Level	Minimum 5 subjects at Grade C/4+ including Maths & English
IELTS	6.5–7.5 overall; no individual band below 6.0
TOEFL iBT	90–110 (accepted as alternative to IELTS)
Personal Statement	4,000 characters via UCAS — written by student
Reference Letter	One academic reference from teacher or school counsellor
Application System	UCAS (ucas.com) — apply to up to 5 universities in one form

Student Visa Application	3 months before course start	Apply after receiving CAS number

Pakistani A Level A*	= UK A Level A*	Direct equivalence — fully recognized
Pakistani A Level A/B	= UK A Level A/B	Direct equivalence — no conversion
IGCSE Grade A / A*	= GCSE Grade 7–9	Directly equivalent — no translation needed
Matric + FSc	Case-by-case basis	Some unis require foundation year — verify via ECCTIS
Pakistani CGPA (for Masters)	Converted via ECCTIS (formerly NARIC)	Use ecctis.com for official verification

PRO TIPS FOR PAKISTANI STUDENTS

1. Apply through UCAS — one form, up to 5 universities. Start in September for best choices.
2. Oxford and Cambridge require separate admissions tests (MAT, BMAT, TSA etc.) — prepare 3–6 months early.
3. Use ECCTIS (ecctis.com) to get an official equivalency statement for your Pakistani qualifications.
4. A strong personal statement is essential — UK admissions is not purely grade-based.
5. Chevening is the gold standard scholarship — apply even if you feel underqualified; the interview matters most.
