SCHOLARSHIPS & FUNDING — COMPLETE BREAKDOWN

DAAD Scholarship (Masters)

FULL FUNDING

Coverage: €992/month stipend + health & accident insurance + travel allowance. Tuition is already FREE.

Who: Masters students — strong academic record + 2 yrs work experience preferred | Awarded by: German Academic Exchange Service (daad.de)

DAAD Scholarship (PhD)

FULL FUNDING

Coverage: €1,400/month stipend (from Feb 2026) + full insurance + travel + research allowance

Who: PhD researchers — requires a German professor supervisor acceptance | Awarded by: German Academic Exchange Service (daad.de)

Deutschlandstipendium

PARTIAL

Coverage: €300/month supplementary stipend — funded 50% by federal govt, 50% by sponsors

Who: All students — based on academic merit and social engagement | Awarded by: Federal Ministry of Education & Research

Erasmus+ Scholarship

PARTIAL

Coverage: €800–1,200/month for exchange/joint Masters programs in Europe

Who: Students in Erasmus Mundus Joint Master programs | Awarded by: European Union

HEC Germany Scholarship

FACILITATION

Coverage: HEC Pakistan facilitates DAAD and German university scholarship slots for Pakistani students

Who: Masters & PhD — apply via hec.gov.pk | Awarded by: HEC Pakistan

A Level / IGCSE Results	Strong grades required — minimum B overall; A grades for TUM/LMU/Heidelberg
APS Certificate	MANDATORY for Pakistani students — Academic Evaluation Centre certificate required for visa

Requirement	Details
IELTS (English programs)	6.0–6.5 for English-medium Masters programs
TestDaF / DSH (German)	Required for German-medium programs — free prep courses available
Motivation Letter	Critical component — must show research focus and connection to Germany
CGPA Minimum	Generally 3.0/4.0 or equivalent — higher needed for DAAD scholarship
Application Portal	uni-assist.de for most universities + DAAD portal for scholarships

KEY DEADLINES & TIMELINE

Milestone	When	Notes
DAAD Scholarship (Masters)	Aug–Oct each year	For programs starting following October
DAAD Scholarship (PhD)	Oct–Nov each year	Check daad.de for program-specific deadlines
Winter Semester Applications	May–July	Most programs start in October
Summer Semester Applications	Dec–Jan	Some programs start in April — fewer options
APS Certificate Processing	Allow 6–8 weeks	Apply early — mandatory for Pakistani students
Student Visa (Germany)	After university acceptance	German Embassy Islamabad — 6–8 weeks processing

PAKISTANI QUALIFICATION EQUIVALENCY

Pakistani Qualification	Equivalent	Notes
A Level (Cambridge)	Directly accepted — equivalent to German Abitur	Strong O/A Level grades highly valued
IGCSE / O Level	Accepted as secondary school completion	Attach certified + attested copies
Pakistani Matric + FSc	Requires APS certificate evaluation	APS mandatory for all Pakistani students
Pakistani CGPA (for Masters)	Converted — 3.0/4.0 minimum typically required	Official transcripts + APS evaluation

PRO TIPS FOR PAKISTANI STUDENTS

1. Apply for APS Certificate first — it is mandatory for Pakistani students and takes 6–8 weeks. Start this before anything else.
2. Almost all public universities in Germany are FREE — do not pay anyone who claims otherwise.

3. DAAD is highly competitive — your motivation letter and research proposal matter more than grades alone.
4. TU Munich, LMU, and RWTH Aachen have the most English-taught Masters programs — check DAAD's database at [daad.de](https://www.daad.de).
5. Germany's 18-month Job Seeker Visa after graduation is one of the best post-study work pathways in Europe.
